Student Guidelines & Expectations 2021

Completion of the Musical Application Form on Operoo signifies your understanding and acceptance of these guidelines.

Fees & Payment

- Scotch students: \$250.00 per activity per term (2 terms only for the College Musical - total of \$500.00)
- After confirmation of your enrolment, fees for all activities will be charged to Scotch students' disbursement accounts each term. External students will be sent an invoice at the beginning of the year.
- An optional Performing Arts jacket is available to purchase from the Scotch Shop. The cost of the jacket is \$100.00.

Attendance

- The student should attend all scheduled classes and rehearsals. The teacher must be given, where possible, 24 hours' notice in advance if the student will be absent.
- If a student is unable to attend a class or rehearsal, they must notify a nominated staff supervisor directly; messages sent via other students are unacceptable.
- If a student is absent due to extenuating circumstances (e.g. long-term illness), parents must send an email to the nominated staff supervisor.
- We are unable to guarantee the safety of students under Duty of Care obligations if they do not attend their designated class/rehearsal.

Productions

- If successful in becoming a cast or crew member, students are expected to commit to the program of rehearsals and performance as necessary. Rehearsal schedules will be distributed via scotchmusical.com, email and notified via the Scotch Performing Arts Facebook group.

Discontinuation

- A student may only discontinue classes/participation in the Musical after consultation between a parent/guardian, the tutor and/or the Head of Performing Arts.
- Both the tutor and the Head of Performing Arts should be notified in writing before the end of the term. No refunds apply when a student ceases to participate.
- The tutor and/or the Head of Performing Arts may terminate lessons in the event of non-payment of an account or if the student fails to abide by the guidelines. Fees will not be refunded.

Please note: Some physical contact may be necessary by members of the faculty during classes, workshops and performances to demonstrate exercises or techniques; make corrections to posture; assist with hair, make-up and fitting of costumes; and to administer first aid.
