

Celebrating the Class of 2019

Our Centenary class have done themselves and their community proud with what is a remarkable set of achievements for the dual awards of the SACE and the ATAR.

Our belief in the premise from great relationships comes great learning has certainly been evidenced. Our students have smashed existing records with an astounding 54 students achieving an ATAR of 90 or above. The 8 students who gained 99 or above, placing them in the top 1% of the nation, have left us in awe of their talents.

In this our largest Year 12 graduating class ever, there are many individual success stories. We take great pride in acknowledging those who have faced illness, adversity or a tricky journey over their schooling. It is their success today that is a hallmark of individual resilience and tenacity for which Scotchies are known.

Results at a glance for the 2019 cohort:

- 54 students with an ATAR of 90 or above
- 38 students with achieved a score of 95 or above
- 8 students with a score over 99
- 37 Merits across 13 subjects, of these 13 were achieved by Year 11 students
- 100% SACE completion

College Principal, Dr Newton, has commented from slightly cooler climes in the Northern hemisphere, that “The achievement of these results is a tribute to our students, their teachers and their families. What a wonderful way to conclude our centenary year firmly placing Scotch at the forefront of achievement in South Australia and across the nation. When we reflect on the fabulous results of the entire cohort, achieved across many areas of our dynamic offering, we know they have been prepared well to lead successful lives. Congratulations and well done!”

Our graduating students are proud of their results and many have contacted the school expressing their gratitude and delight. We congratulate Jake Bastian who achieved an ATAR of 99.75 and has received today a Governor’s commendation. Over his SACE studies Jake achieved a remarkable 5 merits.

In addition to the fine achievements of the Class of 2019 students there are many other strong results for our current Year 11 students.

In the subject Research Project, 48 of our students achieved in the A grade band.

In all 93 Year 11 students studying a Stage 2 subject achieved in the A grade band. This bodes well for next year, which promises to be another high performing cohort.

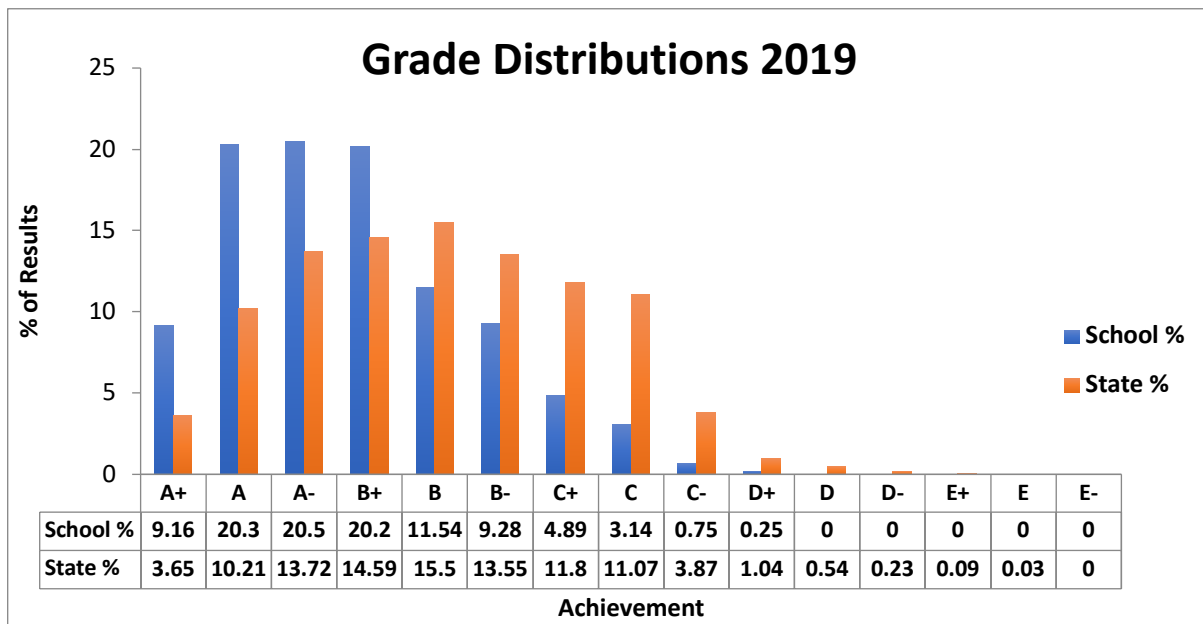
