

# SCOTCH COLLEGE ADELAIDE Oughton Scholarship Terms and Conditions

#### 1. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1 To be eligible for an Oughton Scholarship at Scotch College Adelaide (the College), applicants must be Australian or New Zealand citizens or holders of an Australian Permanent Residence Visa who are:
  - 1.1.1 New students entering Year 10
  - 1.1.2 This scholarship will be means tested

A student is eligible for only one scholarship at any given time. Additional fee reductions cannot be applied.

#### 2. SELECTION CRITERIA

- 2.1 This 3-year scholarship recognises and encourages students who demonstrate
  - 2.2 Sound academic attitude and achievement
  - 2.3 An exemplary work ethic
  - 2.4 Participation in either sport, performing arts, music and co-curricular activities
  - 2.5 Social awareness
  - 2.6 Leadership, service and commitment to making a positive difference.

### 3. GENERAL EXPECTATIONS OF ALL SCOTCH COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP HOLDERS:

- 3.1 Scholarship holders are role models and ambassadors of the College. They must demonstrate high standards of behaviour, leadership and presentation at all times. They must also set a positive example to the rest of the College; in particular those younger than themselves.
- 3.2 The scholarship holder should maintain a high commitment to their studies, demonstrated through a positive attitude, effort, and achievement.
- 3.3 Scholars must participate in an additional area of interest within the College.
- 3.4 The scholarship holder must consistently reflect the values of the College including honesty, integrity, leadership and inclusivity.





- 3.5 The scholarship holder must keep the amount of their scholarship confidential and not discuss it with other students, friends, or people outside their immediate family.
- 3.6 The scholarship holder will participate in an annual review regarding their ability to meet the specified expectations of scholarship recipients.
- 3.7 If the scholarship holder does not meet the above requirements, the scholarship may not be renewed at the end of the academic year. In extreme cases, the scholarship may be withdrawn immediately.
- 3.8 A student can hold only one scholarship, which overrides any sibling discounts or special privileges.
- 3.9 Scholarship holders are expected to complete their schooling at Scotch College for the duration of the scholarship. If a student withdraws from the College before completion of the scholarship (3 years), the value of the scholarship up to the time of the student's withdrawal must be repaid by the parent who accepted the scholarship on behalf of the student. The Principal may, at their discretion, waive this obligation or set a lower amount to be repaid by the parent/quardian.

## 4. STANDARDS, ACHIEVEMENT, ENGAGEMENT AND BEHAVIOURAL REQUIREMENTS: All Oughton Scholarship Holders must:

- 4.1 Adhere to the general expectations of all scholarship recipients.
- 4.2 Demonstrate a love of learning and excellence in all academic subjects.
- 4.3 Demonstrate leadership skills and set an example of academic excellence to others with regards to meeting deadlines. The scholar will participate in class and show integrity in all matters related to coursework and homework, including academic honesty.
- 4.4 Demonstrate ambition and be ready to take the initiative to assist others in achieving their learning goals.
- 4.5 Participate fully in opportunities for co-curricular and enrichment, seeking leadership through being an effective role model within the College.
- 4.6 Consistently reflect the values of the College in their demeanour, including acting with honesty, integrity and leadership.





#### 5. OUGHTON SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AND ACCEPTANCE

- 5.1 The Oughton Scholarship, when awarded at over 50%, is granted only under exceptional circumstances. In such cases, parents may be asked to provide financial information to determine the additional level of award that may be provided.
- 5.2 The scholarship award applies to the relevant day College tuition fees. It does not apply to costs associated with uniform, iPad, transport, textbooks and stationery, additional excursions, co-curricular activities, private vocal or instrumental lessons, sundry charges and other personal items. The cost of these items must be paid in full by the Oughton Scholarship holder's parents or legal guardians.
- 5.3 Oughton Scholarship recipients who are new students to the College must pay the application and enrolment fees upon acceptance of the Oughton Scholarship. Current College students are not required to pay these fees.
- 5.4 Oughton Scholarships are awarded with the expectation that the Oughton Scholar will attend and complete their schooling at the College up to and including Year 12. If an Oughton Scholar withdraws from the College prior to the completion of Year 12, the full value of the scholarship funds awarded for the period up to withdrawal must be repaid in full to the College. In extenuating circumstances, the College in its sole discretion, may waive this requirement.
- 5.5 These Terms and Conditions should be read in conjunction with the College's applicable Student Enrolment Agreement, as amended from time to time.

#### 6. SCHOLARSHIP REVIEW

- 6.1 The College reserves the right to review the performance of the Oughton Scholar at any time.
- 6.2 Oughton Scholars will participate in periodic progress reviews to ensure they are conducting themselves according to the expectations of an Oughton Scholar. Oughton Scholars will work positively towards meeting all progress goals established as part of the review process.
- 6.3 The College reserves the right to review the terms of the Oughton Scholarship or otherwise, discontinue the Oughton Scholarship in circumstances where the terms and conditions of the Oughton Scholarship have not or are not being met.
